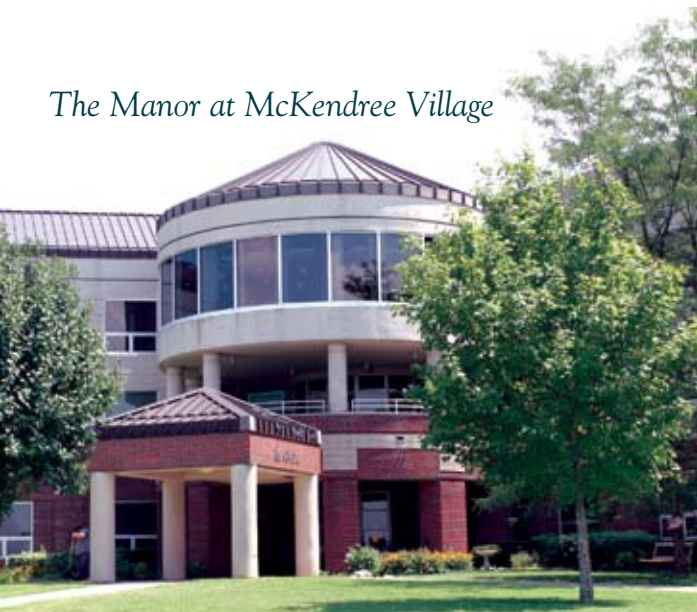
- Single-family homes

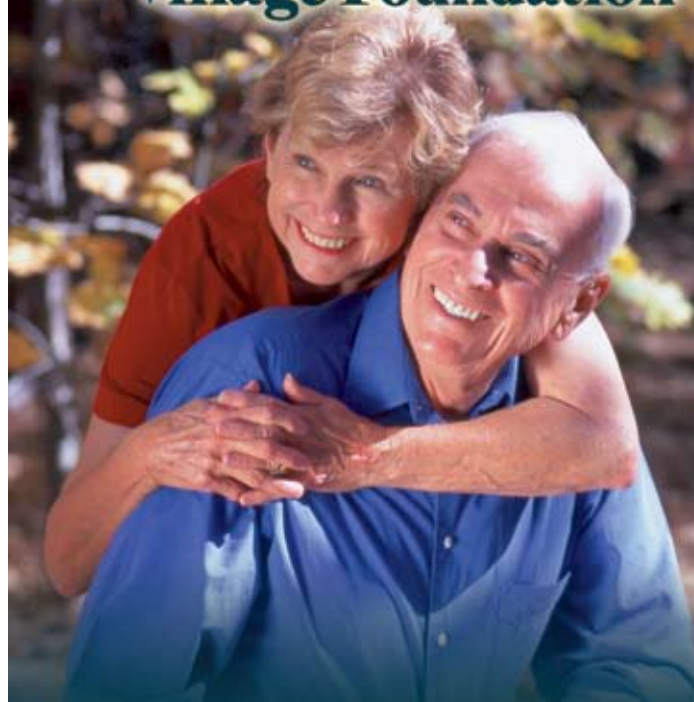

Creating a Better World for Senior Adults

McKendree Village Foundation partners with donors to provide philanthropic support for the work of McKendree Village, whose mission is to provide quality retirement living and health care services for senior adults in a secure, Christian environment.

The foundation raises funds for five primary purposes:

- Benevolent Care through the Golden Cross Fund
- Program Enhancement
- Capital Projects for McKendree Village
- Benevolent Care Endowment
- Pastoral Care Endowment

Founded in 1998, the Foundation is governed by an independent board of directors. The foundation nurtures and sustains relationships between McKendree Village and its donors, seeking at all times to honor donors' wishes and ensure the effective stewardship of their gifts.



Focusing on Benevolent Care



No one will ever have to leave because of an inability to pay. The founders of McKendree Village made this promise with faith, courage and vision. Keeping that promise today requires substantial financial resources. Between July 1, 2000 and July 1,

2006, the foundation provided more than \$7 million in benevolent care funds to meet the needs of over 710 different residents who have outlived their financial resources during this period.

Some of these senior adults required special medical care or rehabilitative services following a stroke or injury. Others need only the continued comfort and security of a loving, caring environment. where they can live in dignity knowing they will not be abandoned.

The generous support for benevolent care through the Golden Cross Fund has enabled the Foundation to keep this extraordinary promise to McKendree residents who have outlived their resources.

Connecting the Gift and the Giver

Gifts from individuals, businesses, foundations organizations and churches enable McKendree Village Foundation to fulfill its purpose.

McKendree Village Foundation receives gifts in a variety of ways.

Annual Gifts - Annual gifts are used for ongoing programs such as benevolent care and general program enhancement.



Planned Gifts - The Legacy Society, established in 2005, includes individuals who remember the foundation in their planned giving through wills, trusts, bequests, life insurance, or charitable gift annuities.

Capital or Major Gifts - These gifts are made to meet a specific need such as a major purchase, improvements or additions to the facility and campus or new or ongoing program support.
